After breakfast we will riding into Kolbeinsdalur and hope to see many of the free herds. Today we will take near horses with us, like in old Icelandic times. This ride takes aroun 2.5hours. After our riding tour and lunch we drive to Hofsós and we will go in the nice swimmingpool there. Later we will have dinner together.

Day 4

Today we start after breakfast our riding tour in the other direction of the Kolbeinsdalur. Also here we will take hand horses with us. After this beautiful ride along the river side for around 2.5hours we will go and visit Holar. In case of the horse museum will be open we will of course go in there as well.



<mark>Day 5</mark>

Today is our last day of riding and after the breakfast we will start to get back to Helluland. We will take another route from Fjall to Helluland where we have a beautiful view over the sea and you can proove what you learnd about chasing horses :). At Helluland we eat the last time dinner and look back to all the nice experiences and impressions of our tour.
